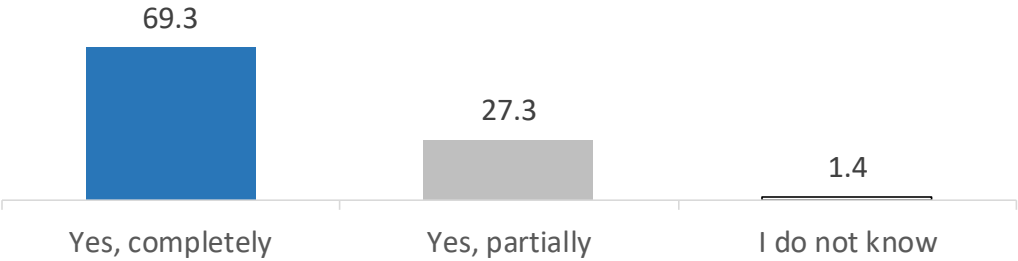

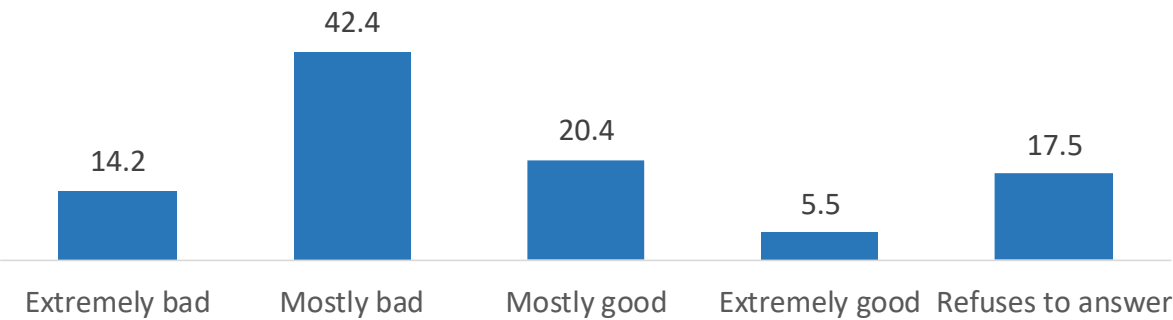

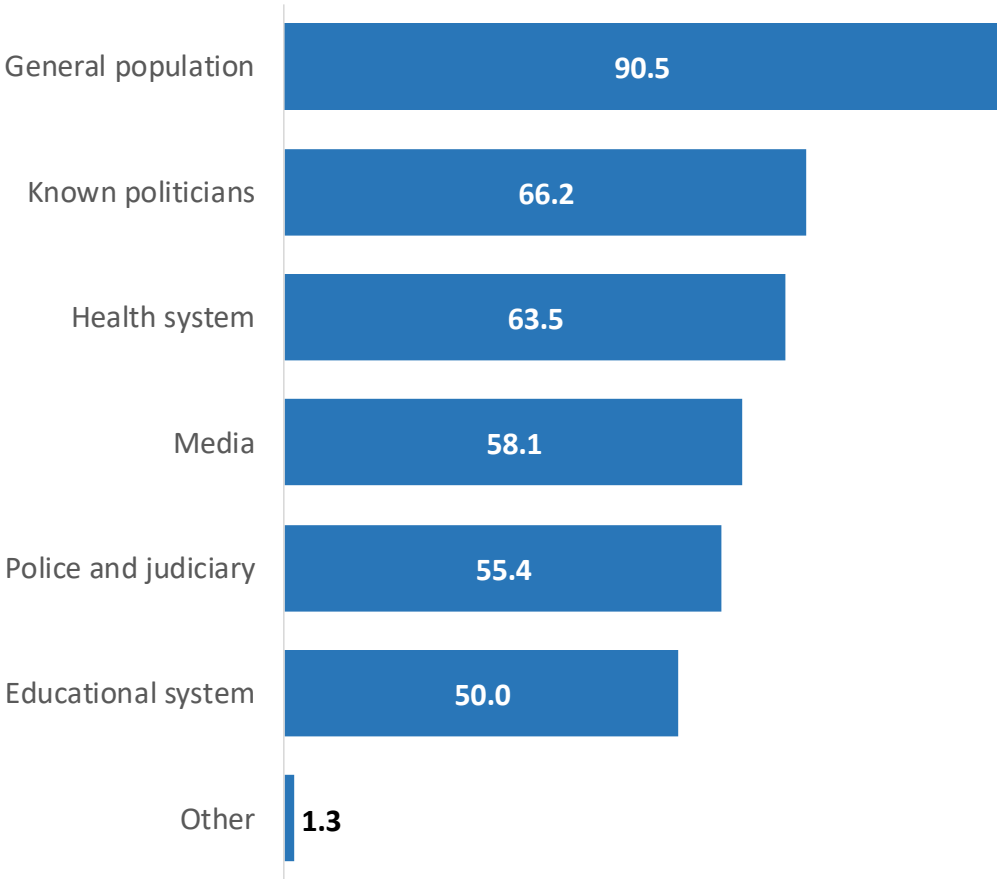
Nationally representative sample (N=2.400): Do you believe that there is a negative attitude toward transgender people in the Republic of Croatia?

LGBTQIA+ community (N=75): Where is negative attitude towards transgender individuals most prevalent?

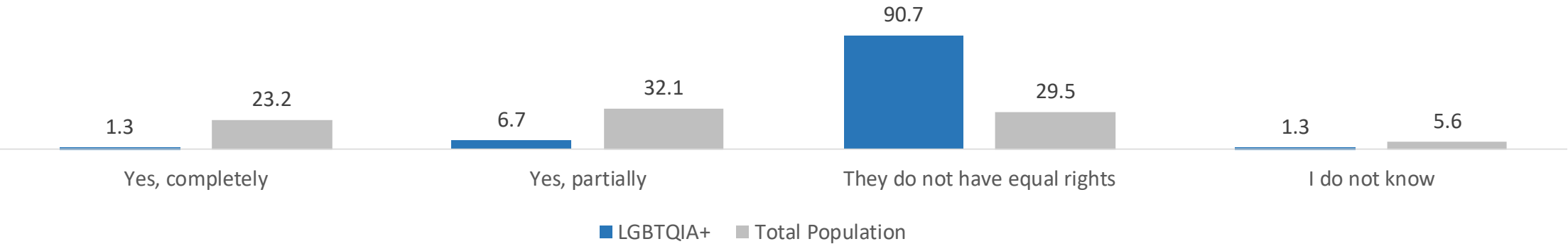


Q8: Do you believe that there is a negative attitude toward transgender individuals in the Republic of Croatia? N=75

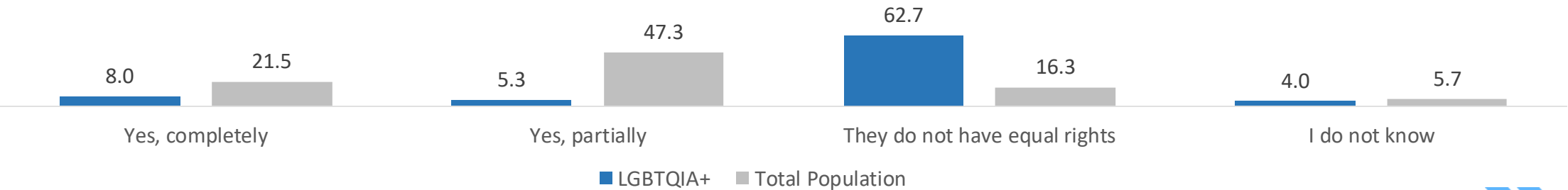
How safe do you feel expressing your gender identity and/or sexual orientation in everyday life?



In your opinion, do transgender people have the same rights as other citizens in the Republic of Croatia?

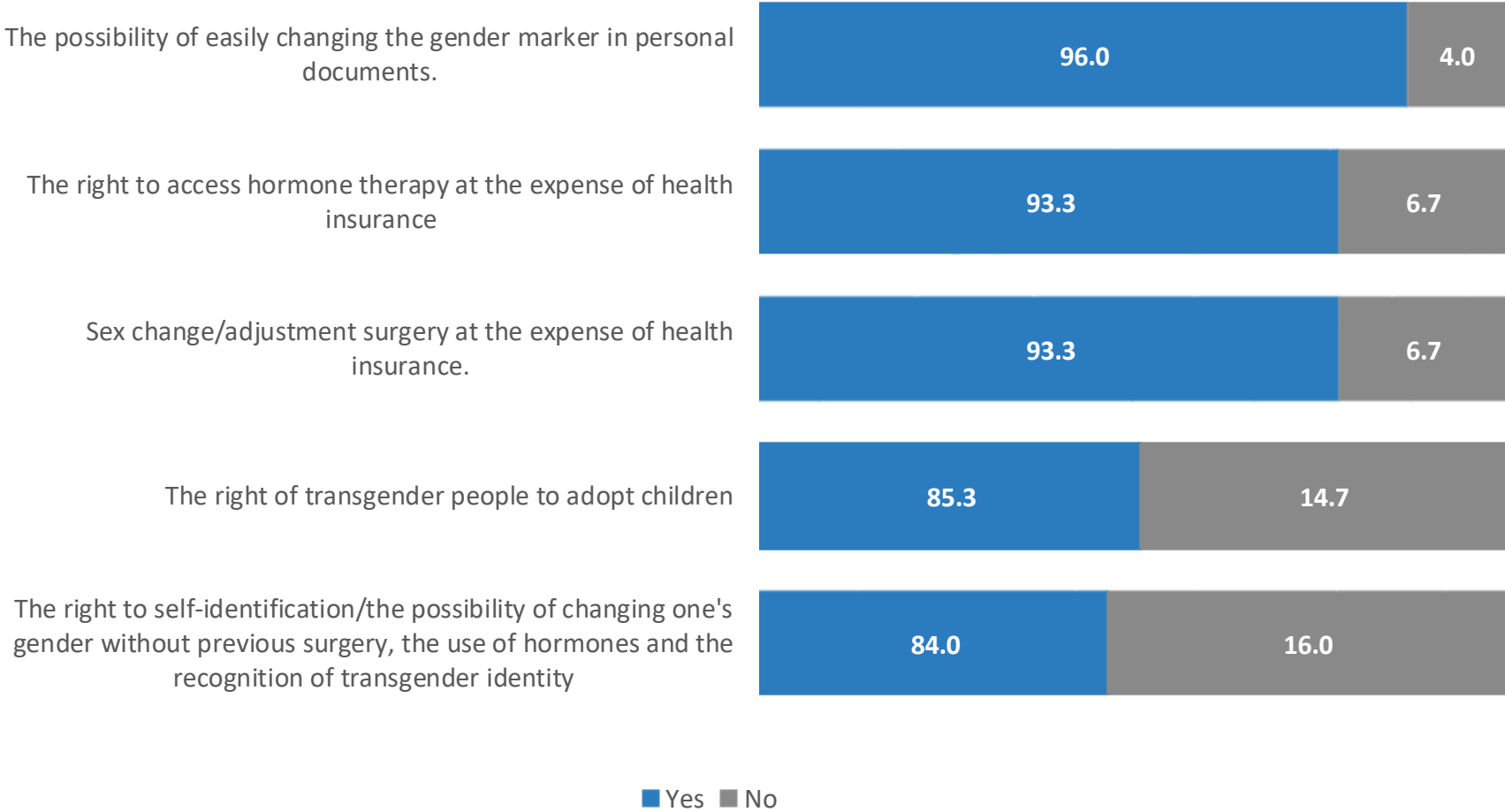


In your opinion, can transgender people exercise their rights like other citizens in the Republic of Croatia?

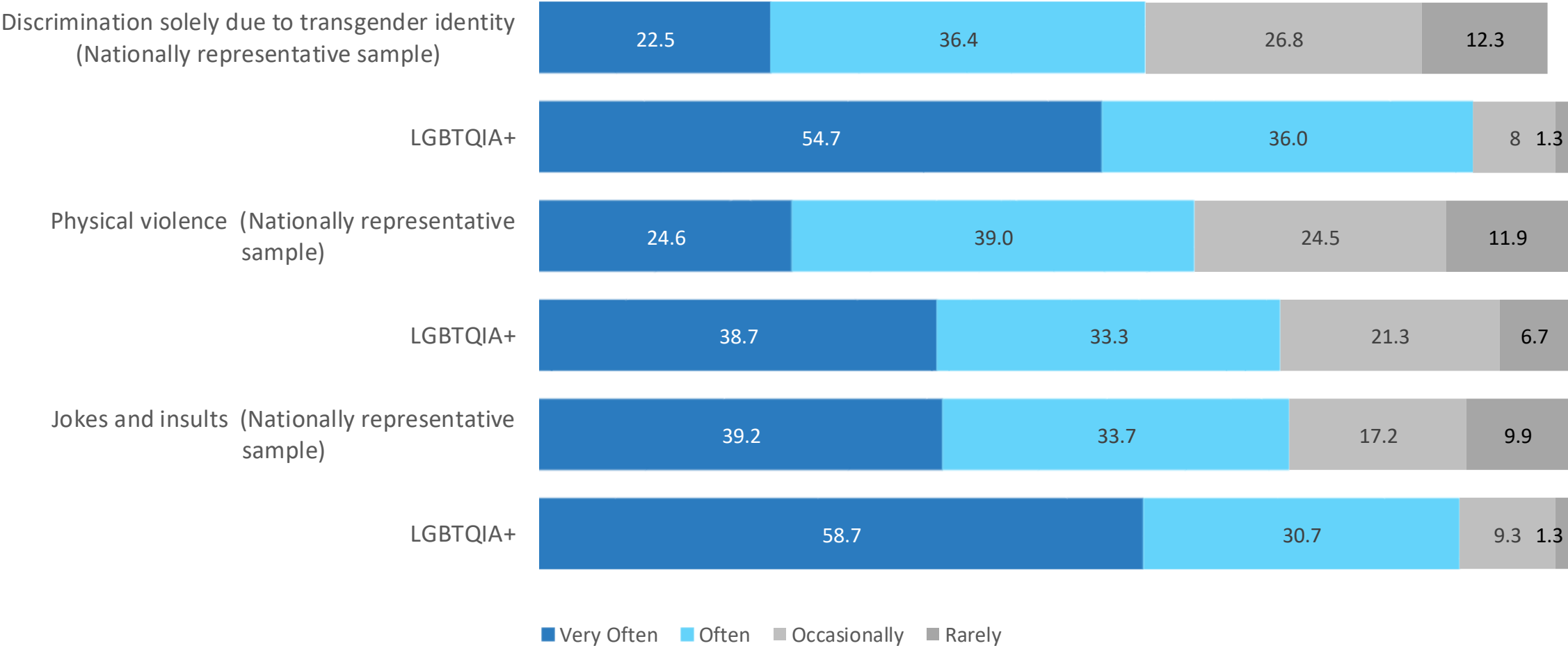

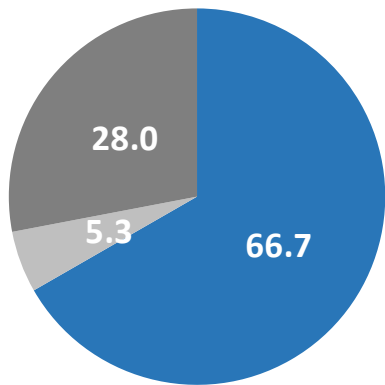

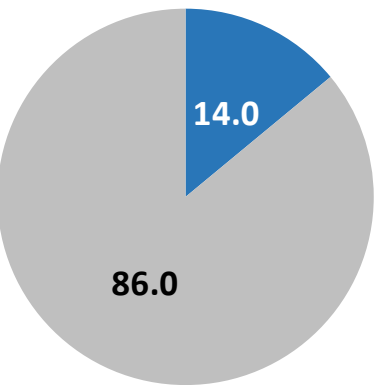

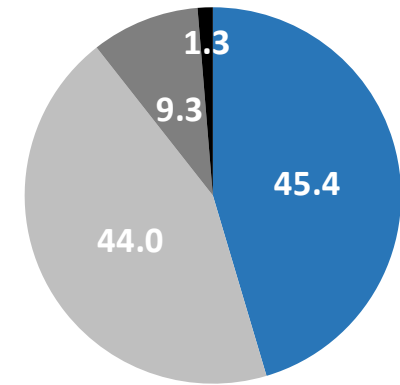

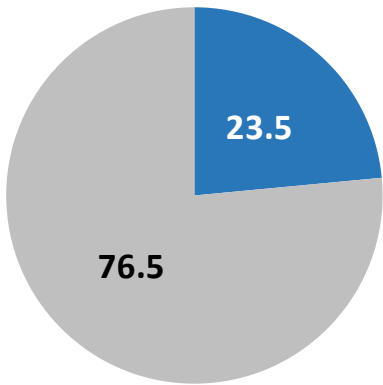

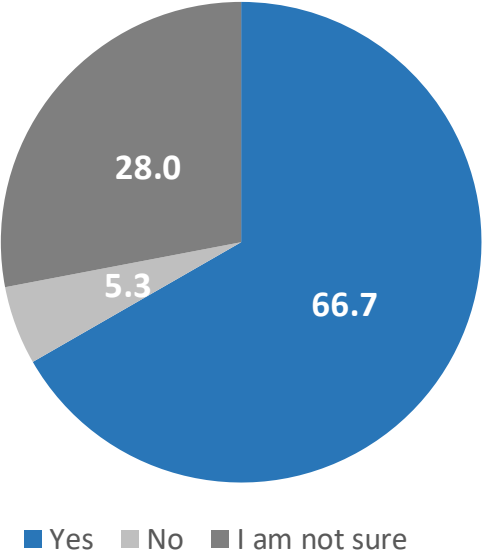

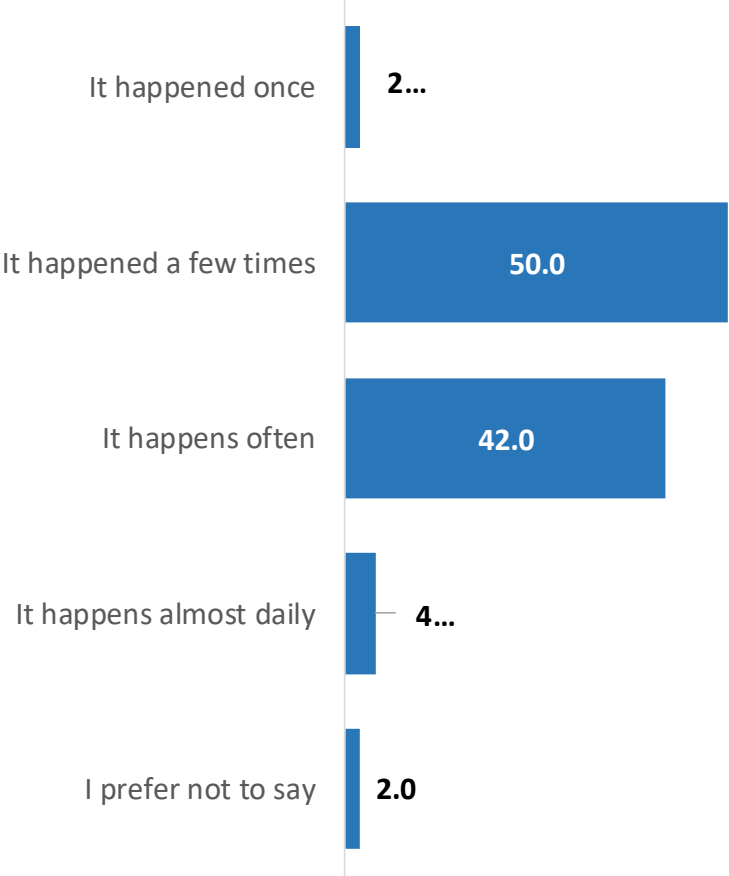

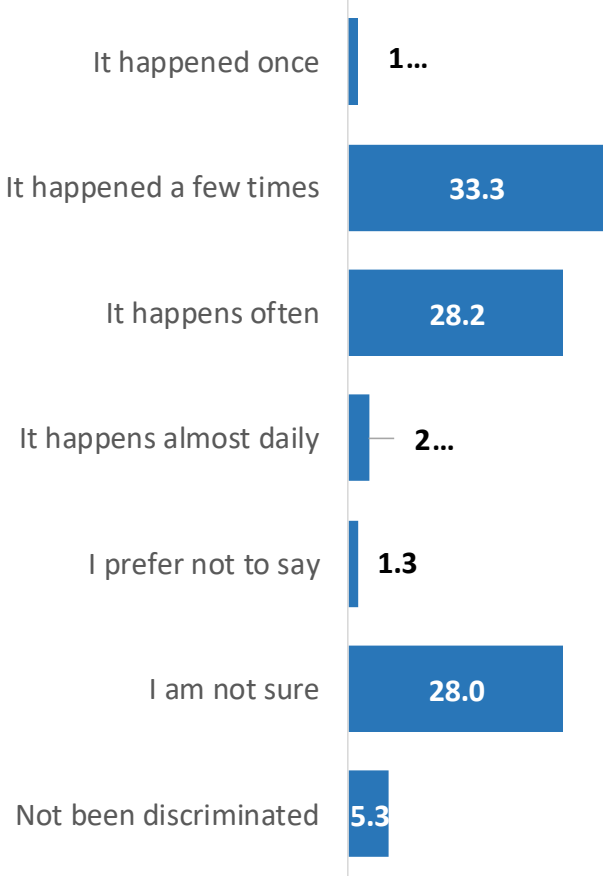

If yes, how often?

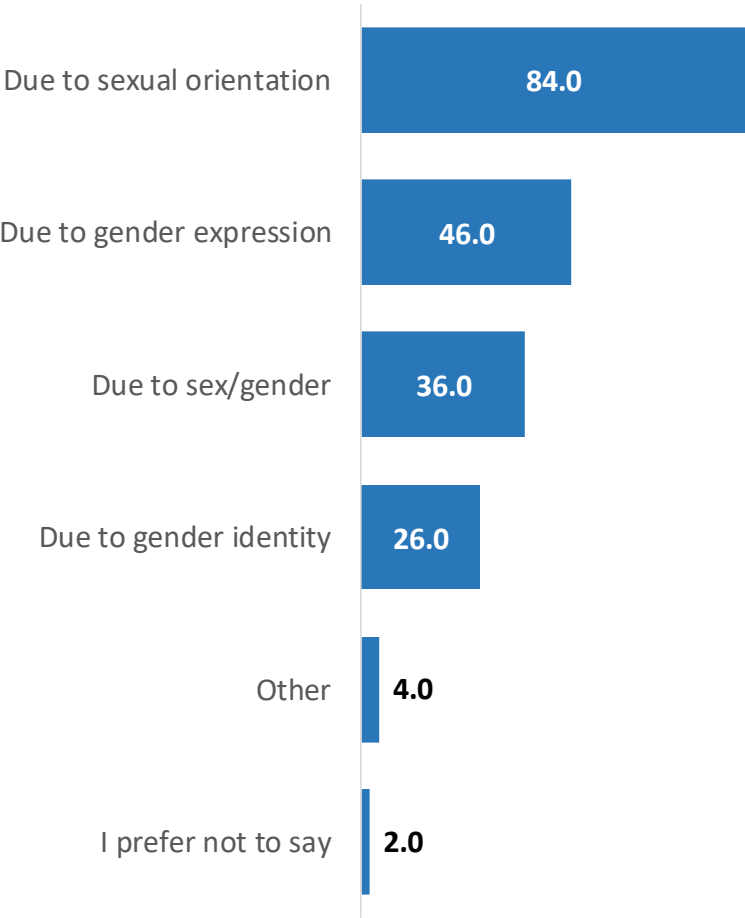

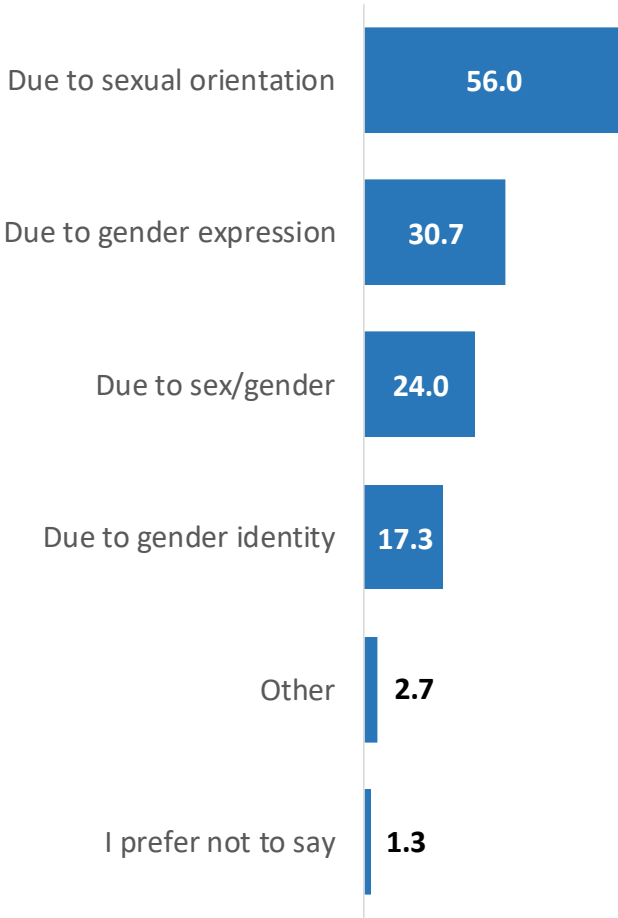

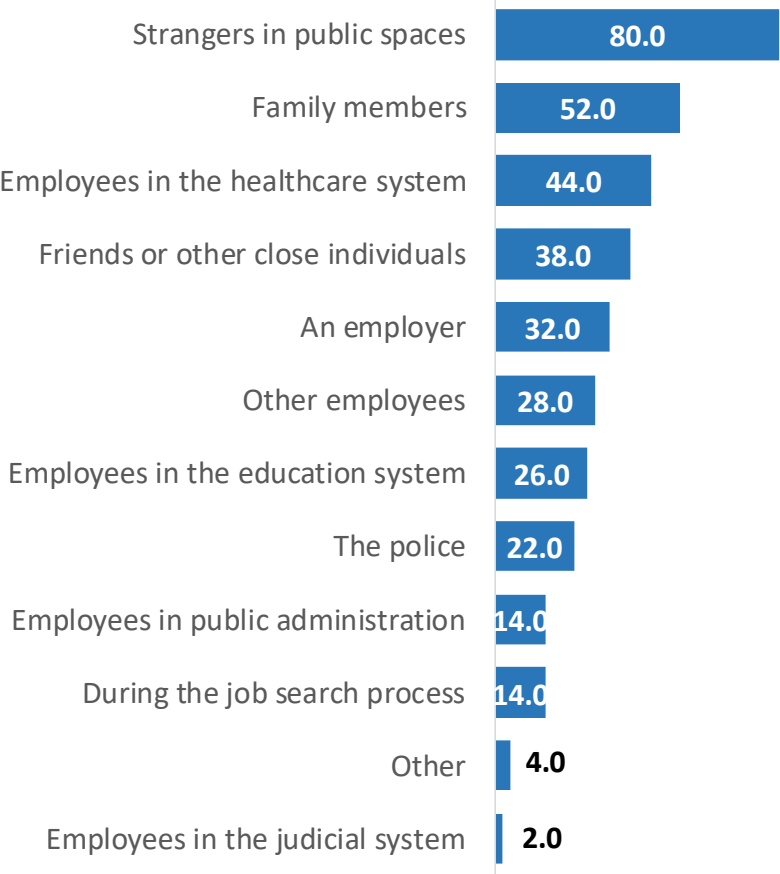

answers possible)?



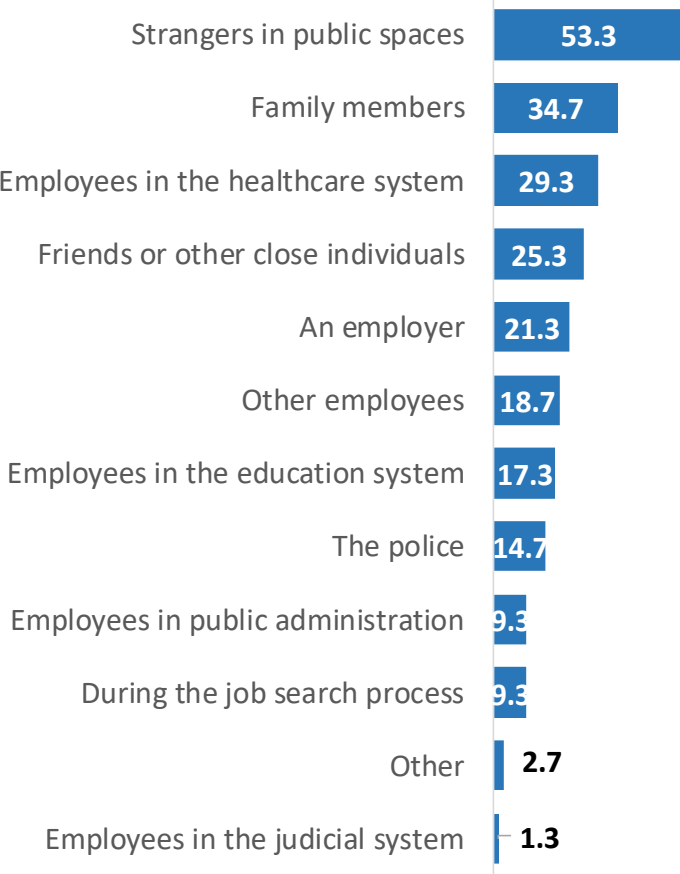

Those who have been discriminated (N=50): If yes, who discriminated against you (multiple answers possible)?

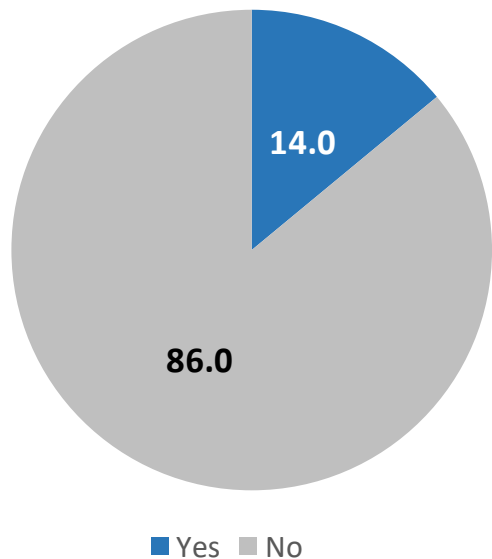

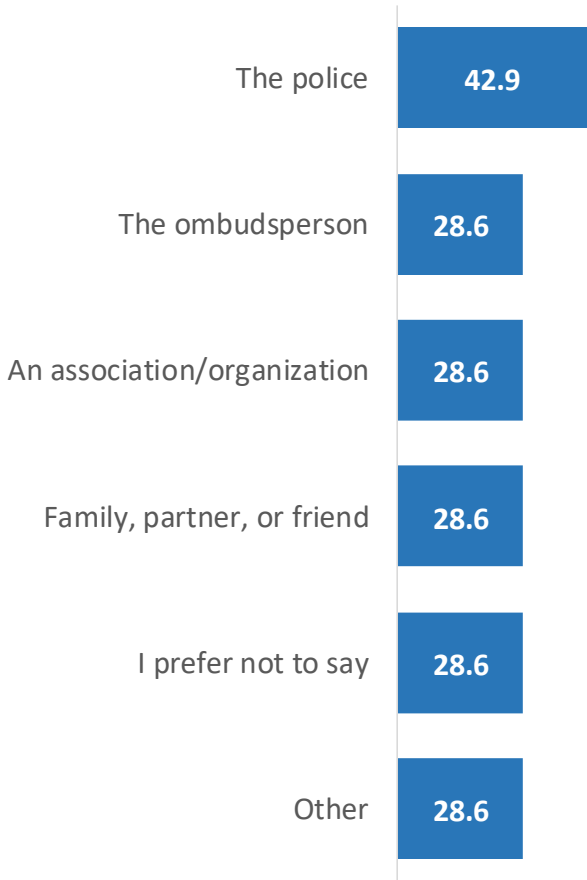

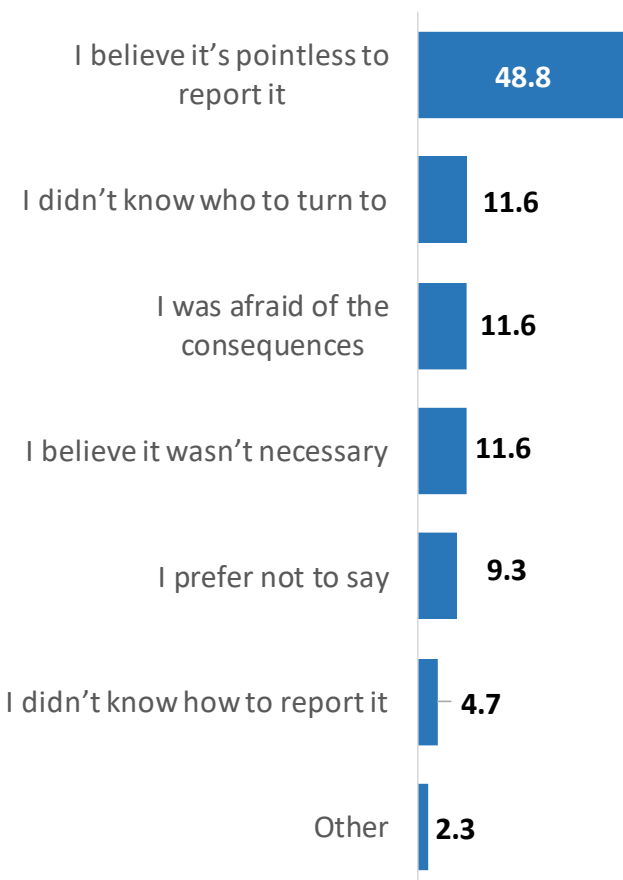

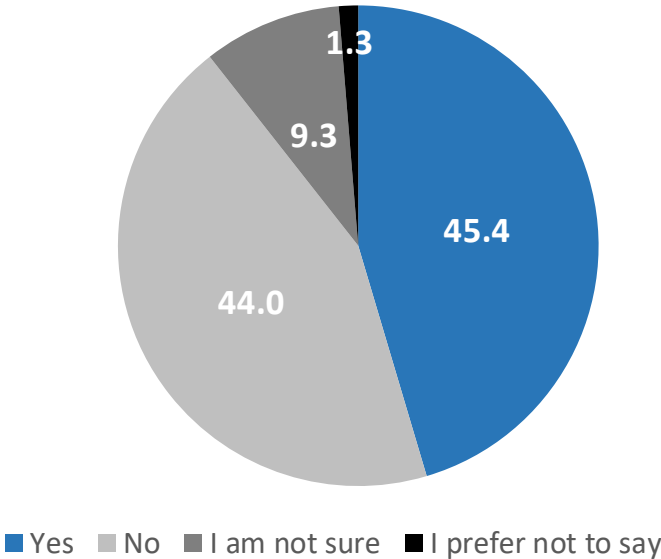

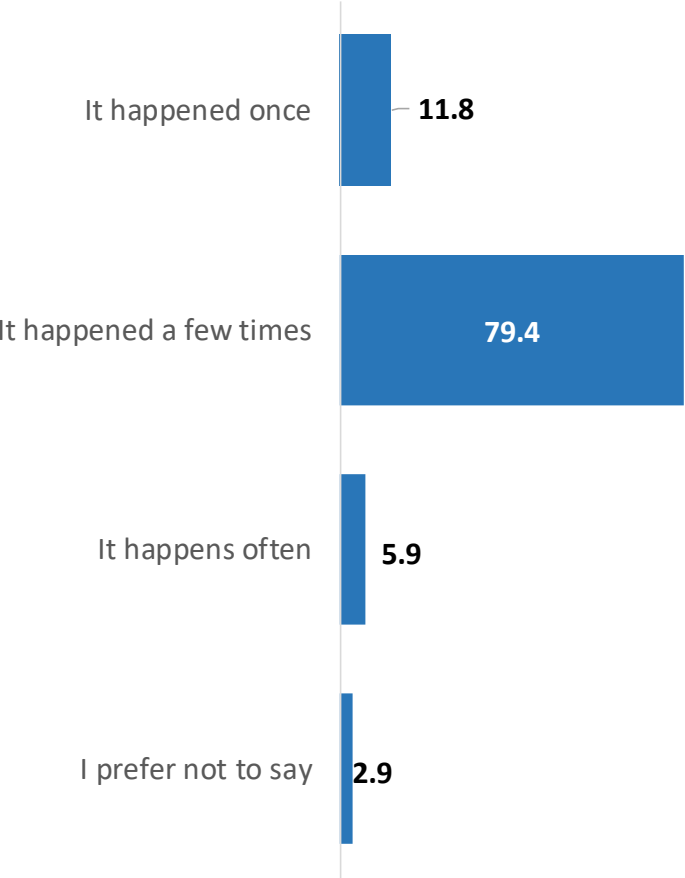

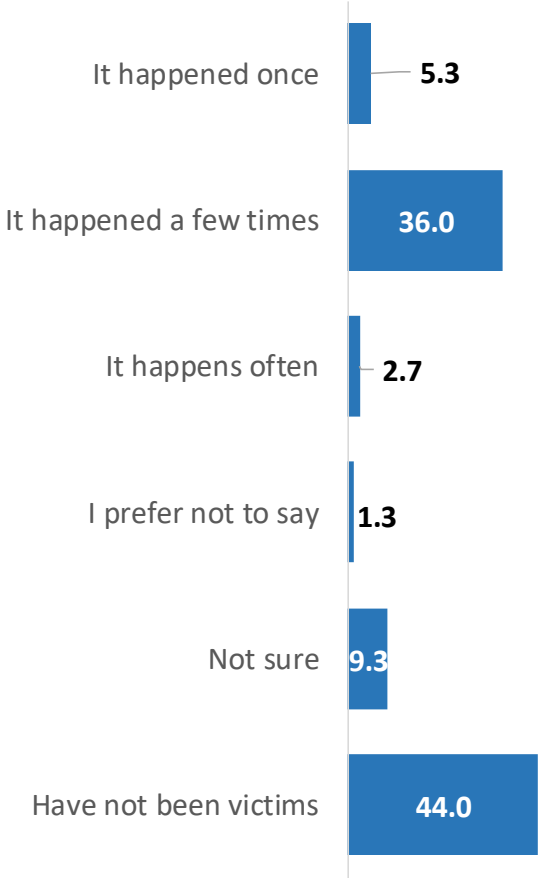

If yes, how often?

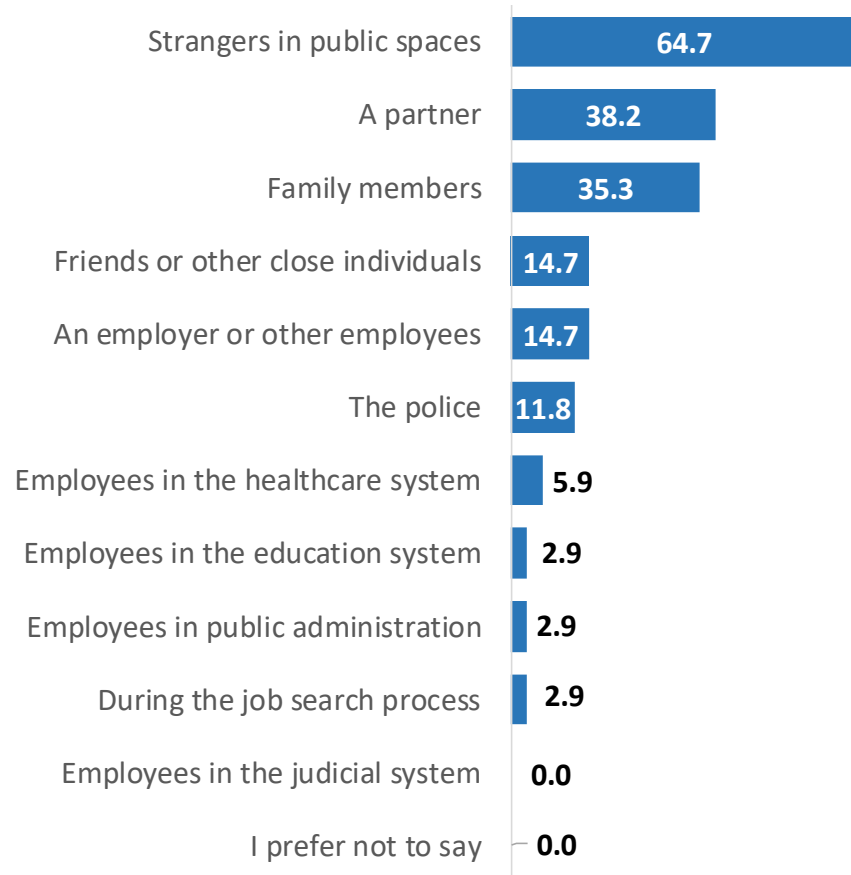

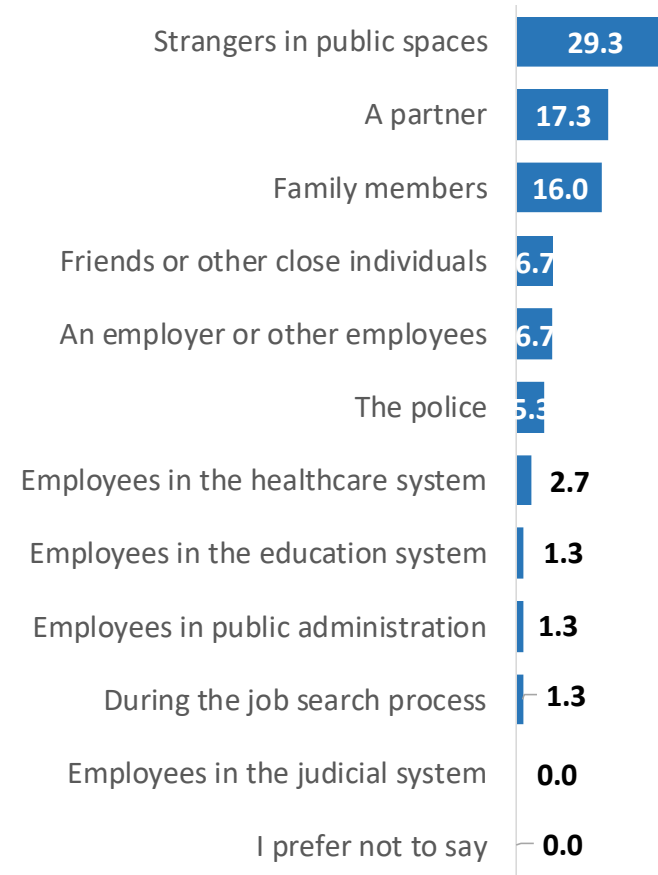

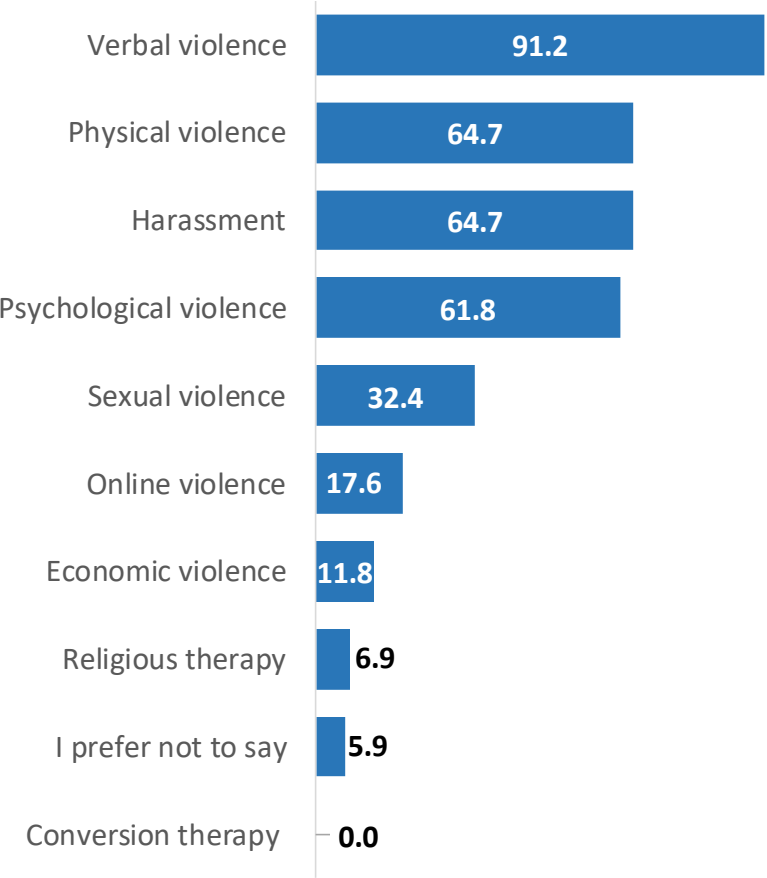

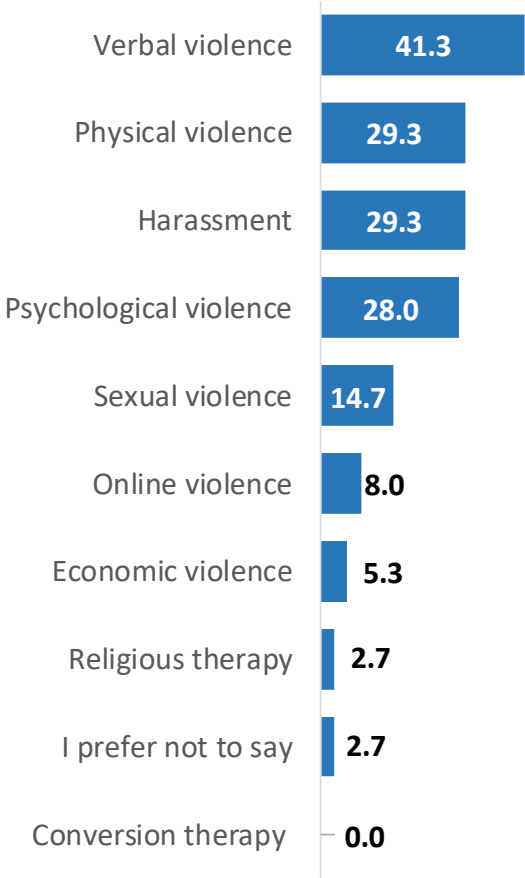

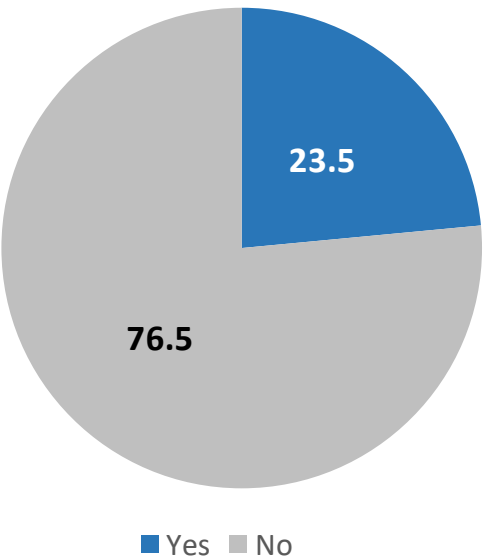
Those who have been victims of violence

(multiple answers possible)?



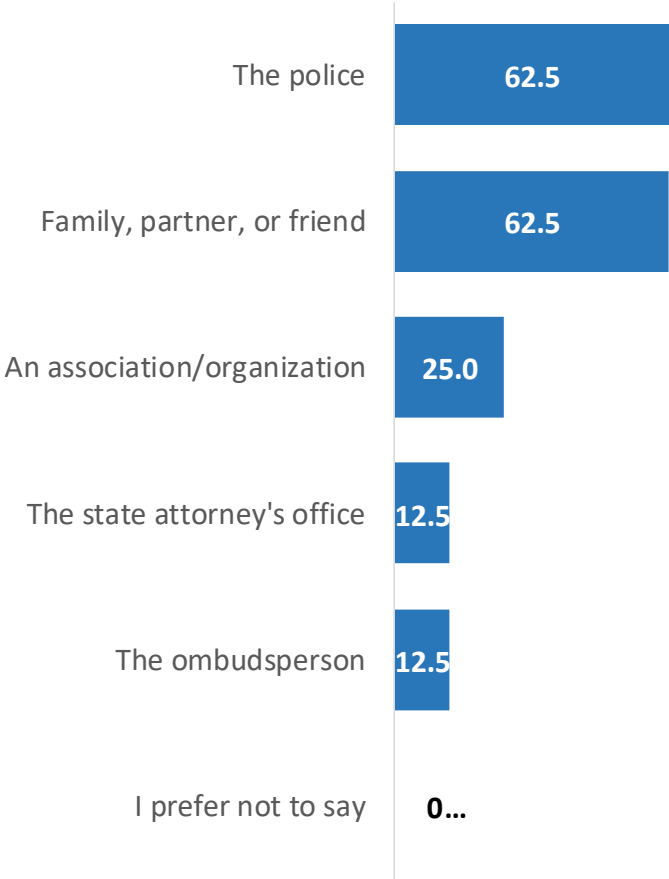

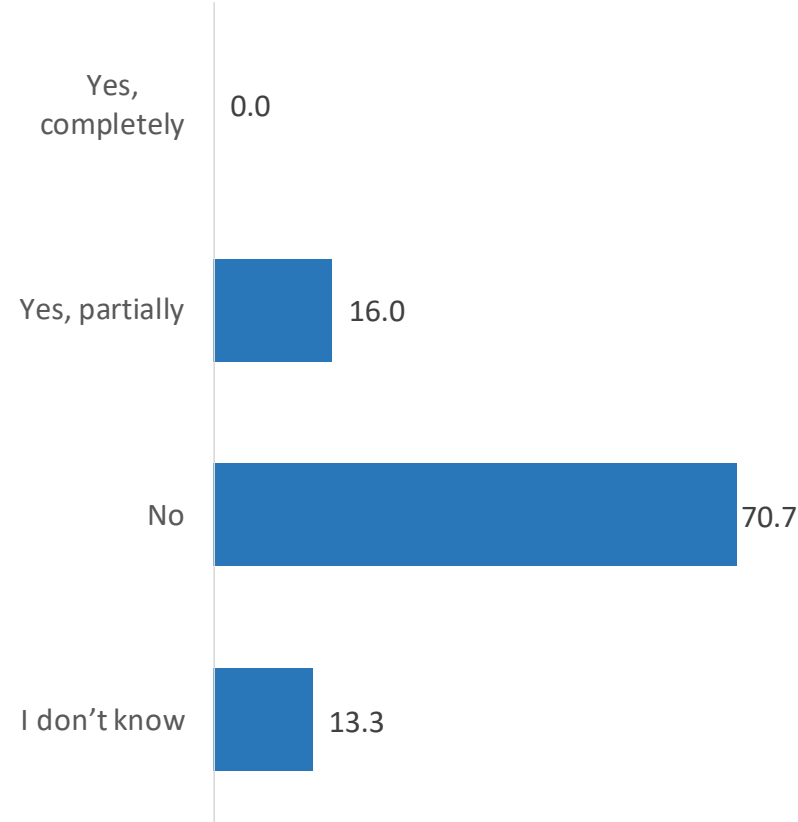

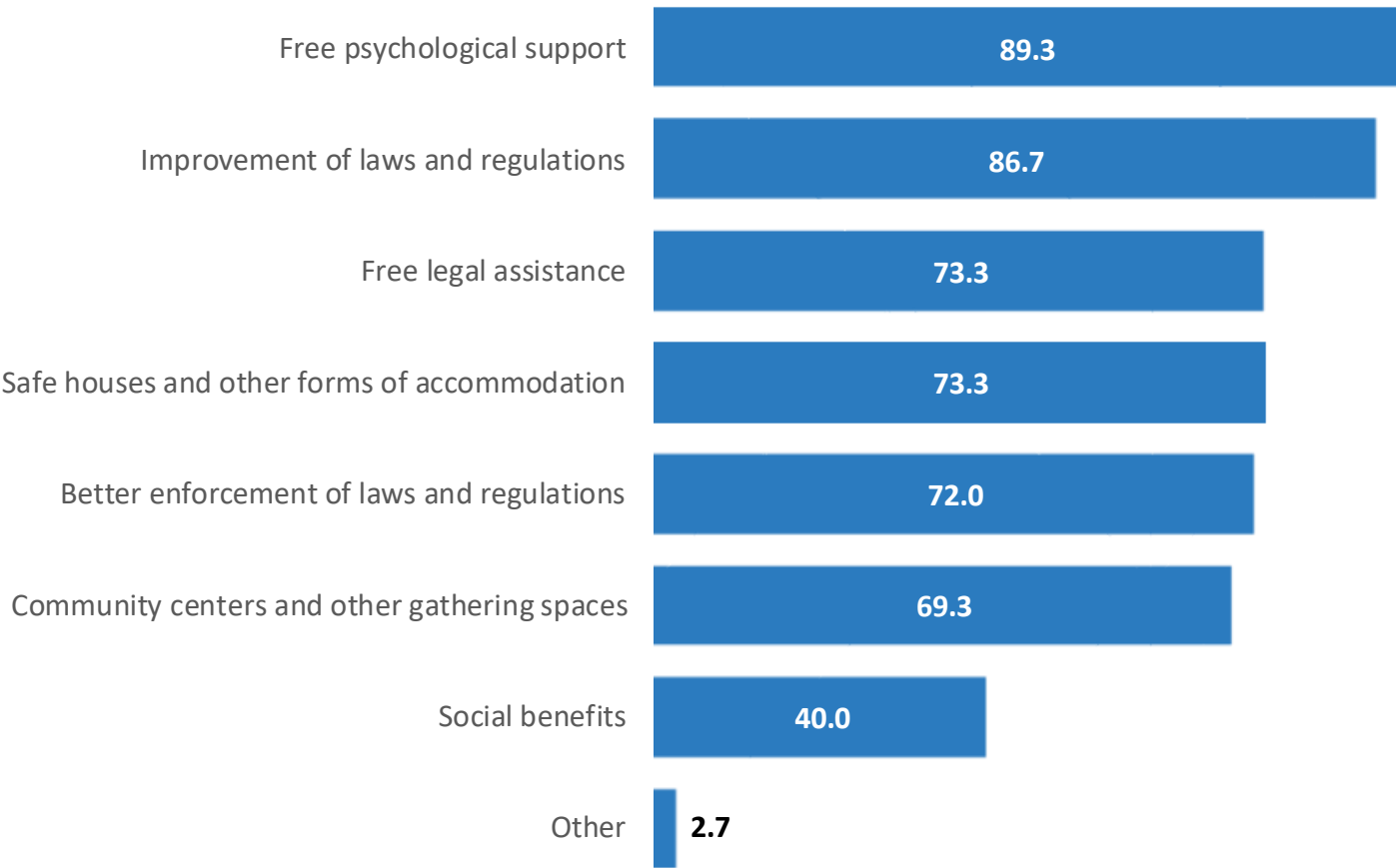

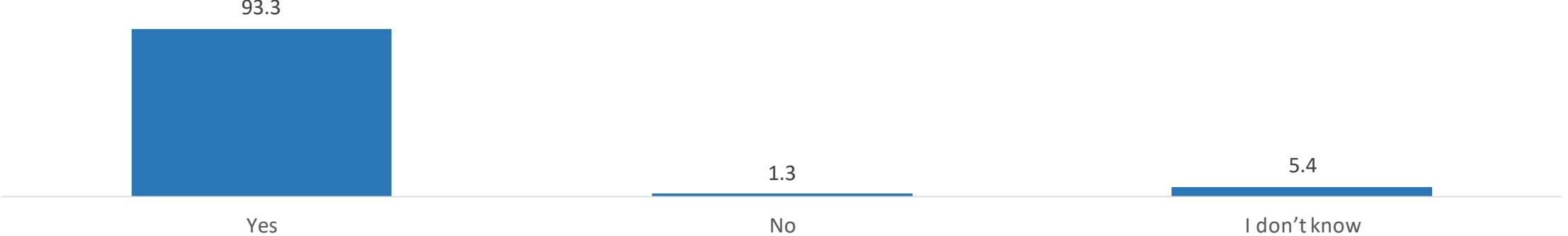


What needs do you consider most important for improving the rights and equality of transgender individuals

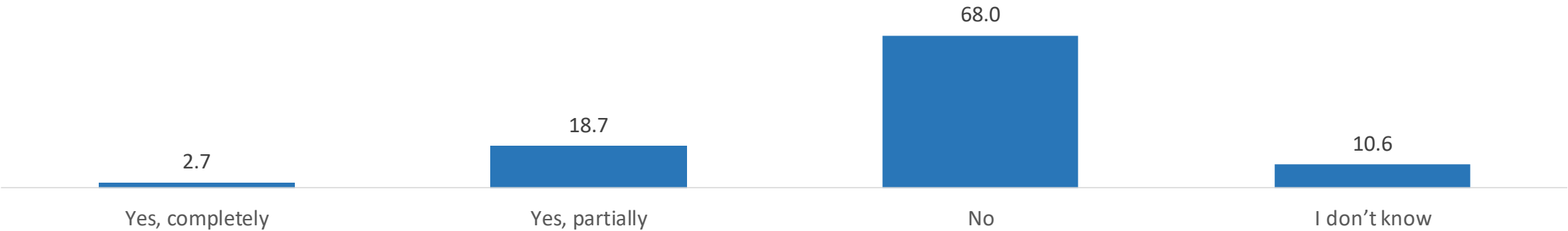

"It would be good if it were easy to find information about transgender individuals who have dual citizenship, Croatian and non-EU, and which laws apply to them when changing their name and gender marker.,,"

"I fear that we are too nonchalant, indifferent, and fragmented to provide the organized resistance that is critically important."

"Accessible and free healthcare for transition purposes; broader/better availability of information on support options, transition, etc.; better availability of information on transgender issues in general—for example, in educational institutions; political mobilization and advocacy."

"Education of society about the issues faced by transgender individuals."

"Easier access to transgender support by ensuring that doctors are not only in Zagreb, as some of us are unable to travel such distances."

"In response to the question directed to KolektIRV about whether there is a support group for transfeminine individuals, I was told that none exists."

"I believe that the state or government institutions should do more to improve the rights of transgender individuals."

"I believe that the media should be adequately penalized for sensationalist, homophobic, and transphobic reporting, which they use solely for clickbait and profit, while harming marginalized communities on whose struggles they profit."

„We are all human."

„We all bleed the same. As a community we need to do better as well."

"The process of freezing sperm/egg cells before transitioning should be made easier for those who wish to do so.,,"

"It is extremely difficult, as a transgender person, to find information on how to proceed when you want to take additional hormones (hormone therapy). It's hard to know where to even start looking or researching, or who to turn to..."

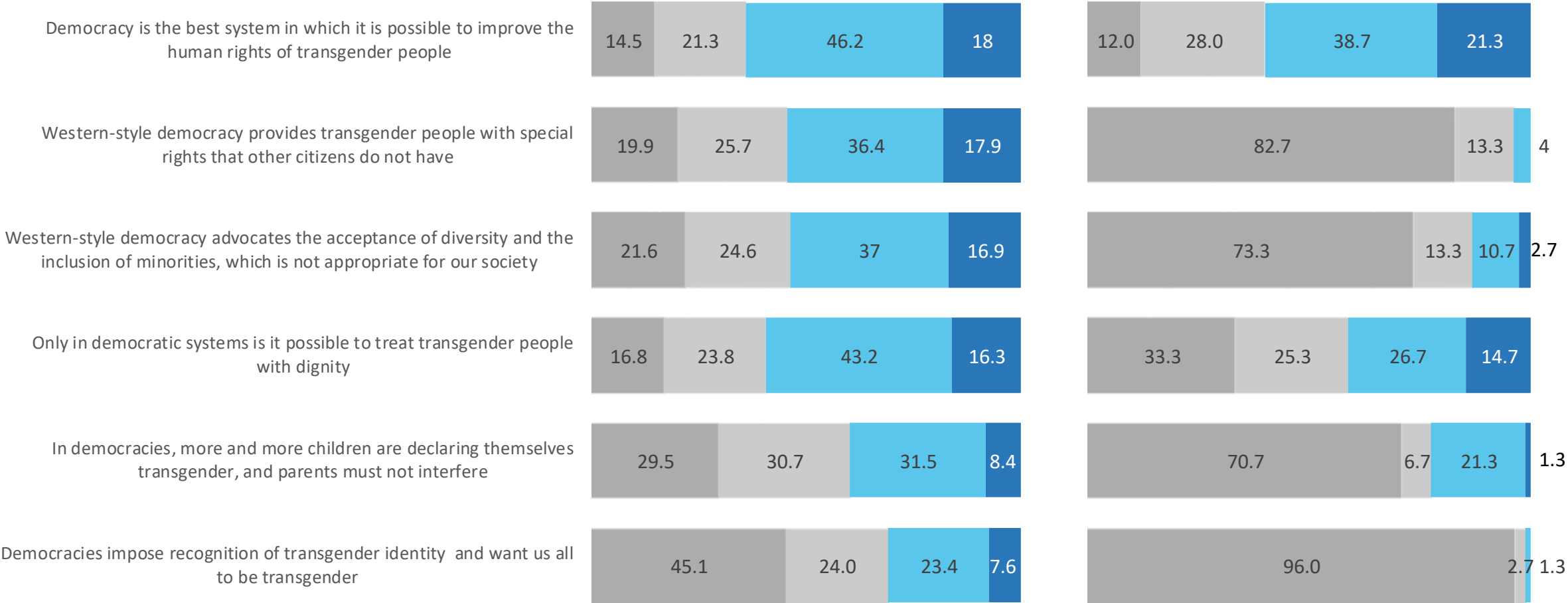

ENVIRONMENT FAVORING ACCEPTANCE OF TRANGENDER INDIVIDUALS



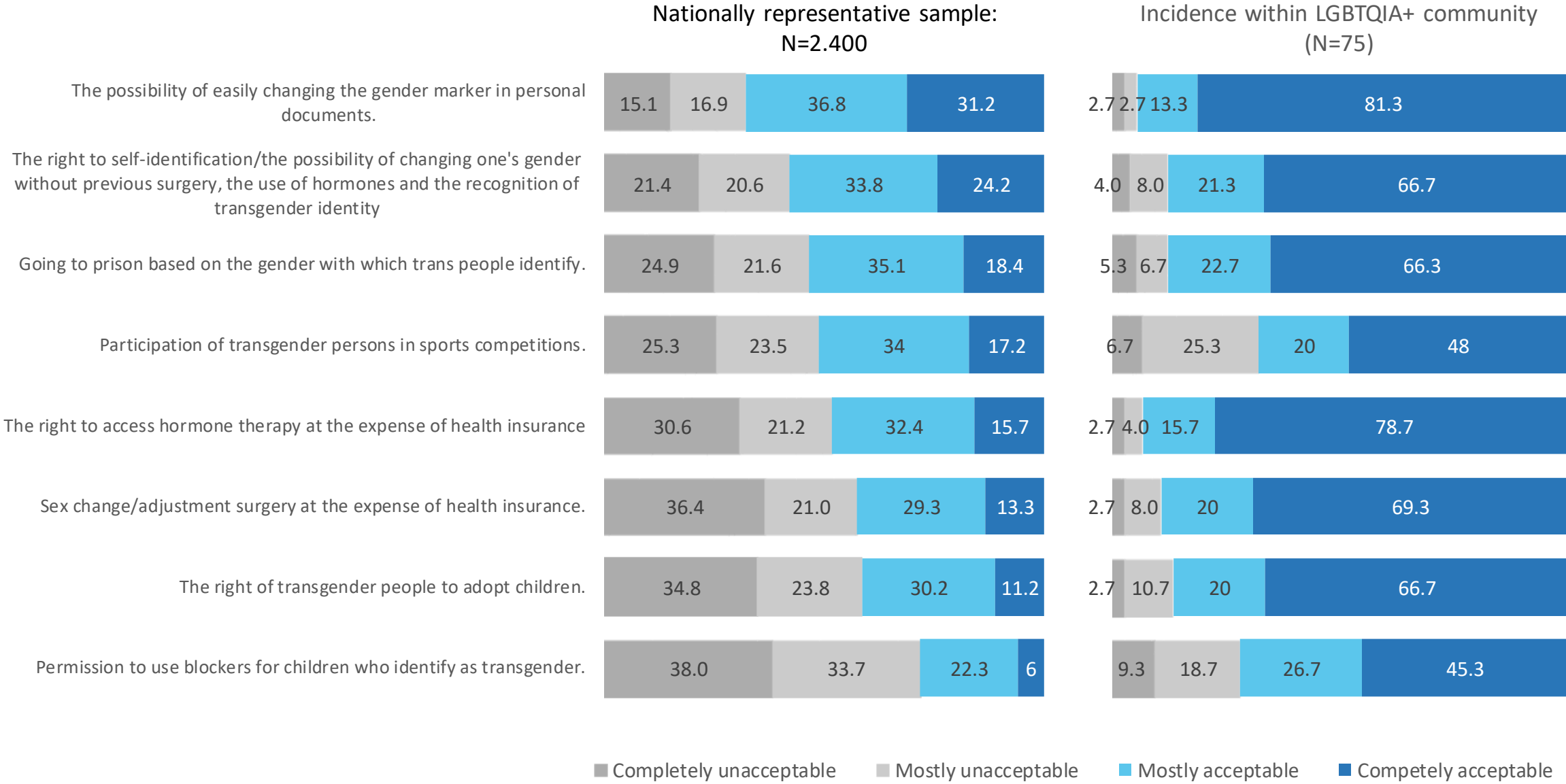

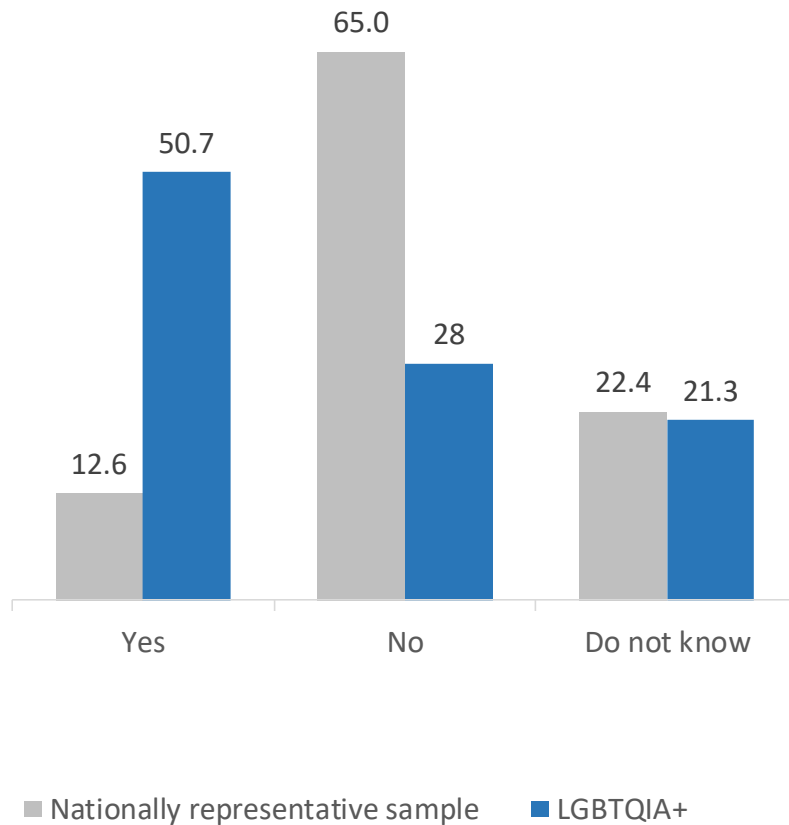

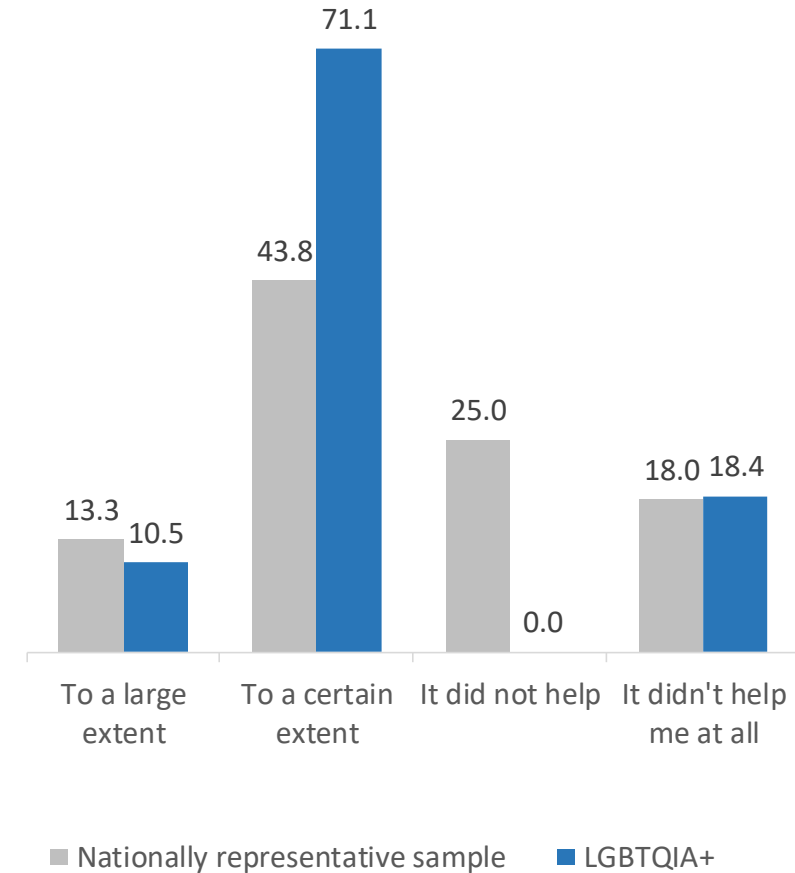

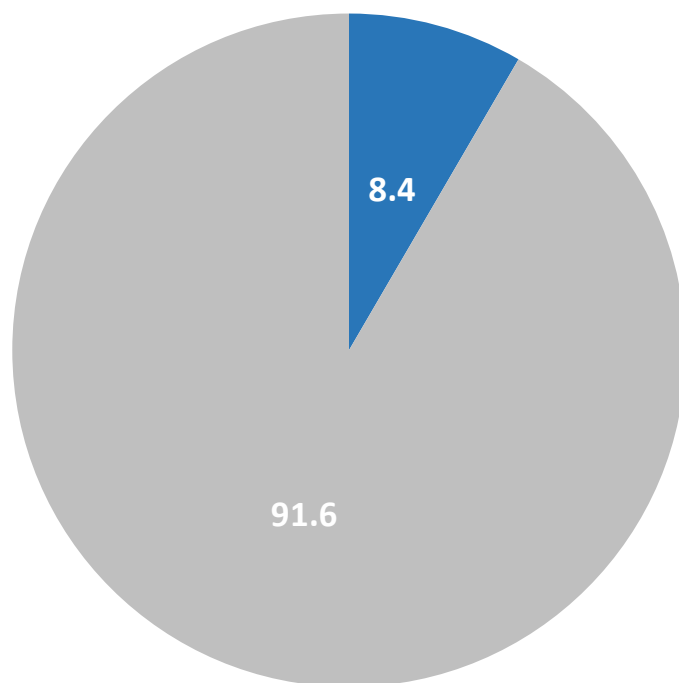
Did you notice a few months ago in the media the campaign „I to sam ja" which talks about transgender people?



Did the campaign „I to sam ja" help you to better understand the problems faced by transgender people?

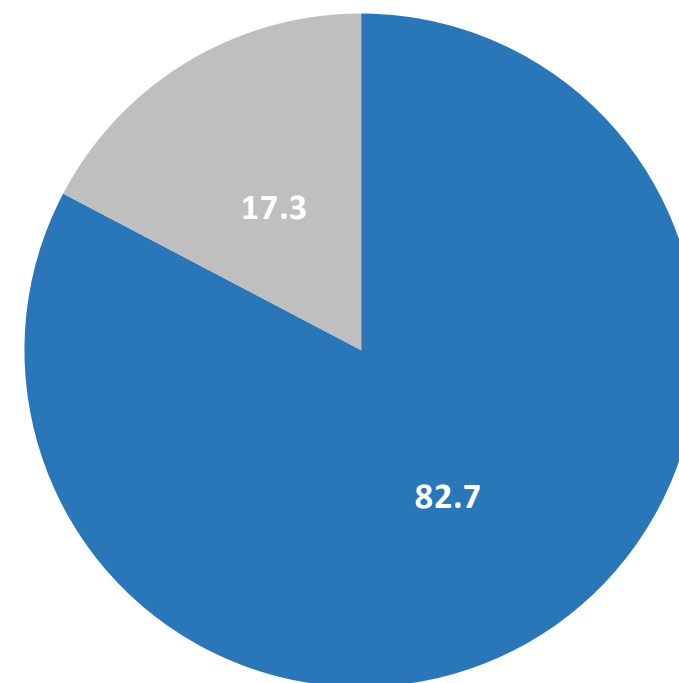

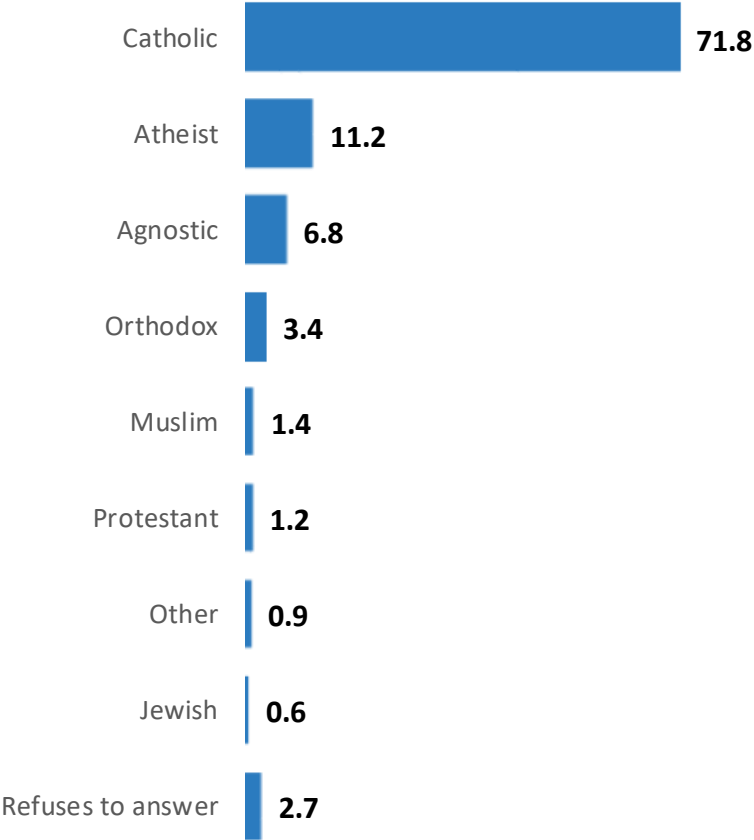

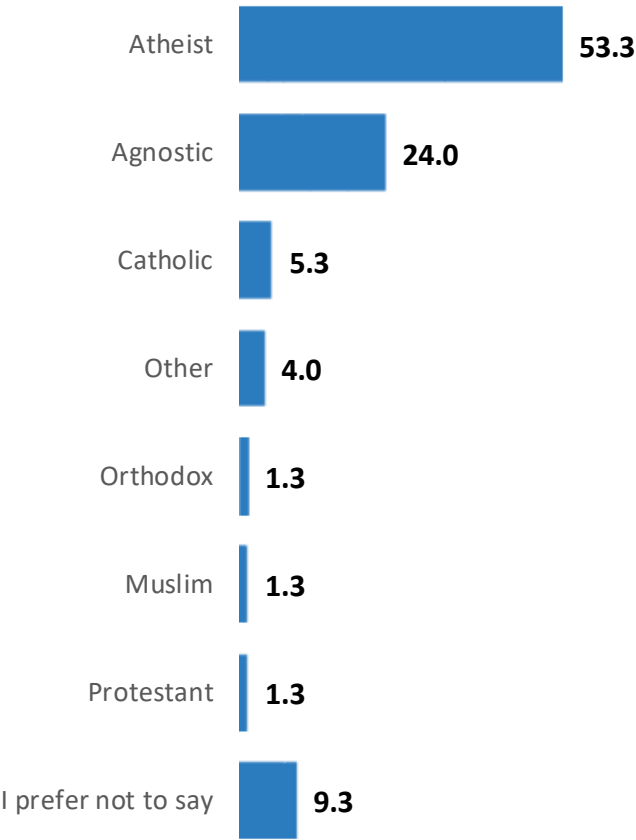
